- "Insert" technology: allows students to form and evaluate their own opinions by making marks based on the text they read.

By using interactive methods in independent learning, not only the process of cognition increases, but also the level of student thinking. Interactive methods can be successfully used in the following forms:

- Mini-projects: Students are assigned a small project work and are asked to independently plan, collect information, process and present it. This method encourages independence.
- Blended learning: Opportunities for independent learning are created through digital means along with traditional education. For example, independent assignments after class via Google Classroom.
- Portfolio methodology: All the work done by the student over a certain period of time is collected and evaluated. This approach helps in monitoring independent activity (Paulson, 1991).
- Peer learning: Students overcome ignorance by explaining the content of the independent assignment to each other. This is an example of both interactive and independent learning.

There are several indicators for assessing the effectiveness of independent learning organized using interactive methods:

- Level of mastery: While the level of knowledge mastery in traditional lessons is on average 60–65%, with interactive methods this figure reaches 80–85% (Rustamova, 2023).
- Activity: Student participation and the number of questions and answers increase. This increases students' interest in the lesson.
- Creativity: By organizing independent learning in an interactive form, students are able to freely express their opinions and develop a creative approach.

Studies show that students' motivation is much higher in groups where interactive methods are used (Freeman et al., 2014).

The role of digital tools

- Kahoot interactive question-and-answer based on a quiz;
- Quizlet independent revision of vocabulary and terms;
- Padlet collect student ideas through an online wall;
- Canva a creative platform for creating infographics and slides.

Through these methods, students can independently search, think and evaluate their own activities.
